1	a) <u>Water Service</u> (combined with 100 mm sewer). New or replacement. Available in 25 mm, 37 mm and 50 mm. 37 mm and 50 mm services shall be installed at cost including overhead.	\$120.00 per lineal meter
	b) <u>Water Service Only</u> New or Replacement. Available in 25 mm, 37 mm and 50 mm. 37 mm and 50 mm services shall be installed at cost including overhead.	\$115.00 per lineal meter
	c) <u>Miscellaneous Items</u>	
	i) An additional charge shall be made for tunnelling or unusual interruption due to gas lines, power lines, buildings or other structures which interfere with normal installation. This charge shall not involve the tunnelling under public-owned sidewalks.	\$275.00
	ii) An additional charge shall be made where it is necessary to cut and replace concrete curbing on the street.	\$100.00
	iii) An additional charge shall be made for tunnelling under public or private sidewalks.	\$100.00
	iv) An additional charge shall be made when it is necessary to cut into a paved roadway.	\$400.00
	v) An additional charge shall be made when it is necessary to cut into a concrete sidewalk.	\$230.00
	vi) Any work or pipe supplied within the premises shall be at cost including overhead.	
	<i>Note:</i> All services above 25 mm shall be at cost including overhead with no flat rate being proposed.	
	d) Deposit for abandoning water service connection due to demolition or removal of the connected building (applicable under Clause 18 of this Bylaw).	\$500.00

c) Special Summer Service Rate

Water for sprinkling lawns and gardens will be supplied at a special rate. The special summer service rate will be the current water rate per cubic meter. A sewer charge will not be added to the summer service rate.

To arrive at the quantity of water used for the sprinkling of lawns and gardens, the average monthly consumption as determined by meter readings of the four months commencing in November or December, as the case may be, prior to commencement of the special rate, shall be considered the amount used for domestic purposes, and the special rate set out herein shall apply to all water used for the period commencing following the May meter reading and ending with the September meter reading when the water meters are read monthly.

When the water meters are read every second month, the special rate set out herein shall apply to all water used for the period commencing following the May meter reading and ending with the September meter reading;
OR

Commencing following the June meter reading and ending with the October meter reading, as the case may be.

In case of services where the rate cannot for any reason be ascertained in the manner above set forth, the City Engineer may set an amount for such services, having regard to all circumstances of the case.

d) The following shall qualify for special summer service water rates:

- Single Family Dwellings
- Duplex Family Dwellings
- Apartments - defined in the Zoning Bylaw as building divided into three or more dwelling units
- All churches
- All schools
- Loretto Convent
- Court House
- Federal Buildings
- Weyburn Nursing Homes
- Weyburn Housing Authority
- Weyburn Union Hospital
- Weyburn Public Library
- City facilities
- Hamlet of North Weyburn
- Weyburn Trailer Court - the consumption eligible for Special Summer Service Water Rates shall be based on a formula taking into account the number of trailers on each site and the average consumption during the period applicable under Clause 2(d) of this Bylaw.

| | b) | Where an outstanding account is deemed to be uncollectible, an administrative charge may be added to the total to offset legal costs, fees charged by a collection agency and/or municipal costs associated with subsequent collection procedures. | \$50.00 |
