

Permit to Deviate from Truck Route
Bylaw 2016-3346 Subsection 19(a)

19 No person shall drive or park a heavy vehicle on any highway / street not designated as a truck route, except; a) Where the owner or operator of the vehicle has obtained a permit to do so from the Director and then only according to the terms of that permit and provided the permit is in the vehicle and available for inspection by police; (Heavy Vehicle - one who's gross weight is greater than 9,000 kg and who's length is greater than 10m)
