

OFF LEASH DOG PARK RULES

- 1. Enter and use at own risk. The Weyburn Community Dog Park Committee or the City of Weyburn assumes no Responsibility for any injury or damage to persons, property or animal, arising from or in connection with the use of the leash-free park.
- 2. Dogs must be wearing up-to-date rabies and license tags.
- 3. Female dogs in heat, sick dogs and dogs less than four (4) months old are not allowed in the park.
- 4. Aggressive dogs are to be kept out of the park. Any dog that becomes aggressive while in the park must be leashed and removed from the park immediately.
- 5. No dog may be in the park without an adult human attending at the same time. All dogs remain the responsibility of the owner or guardian at all times.
- 6. Dogs outside of the park boundaries must be leashed. When in the leash-free park, carry a leash with you at all times.
- 7. Dogs are not allowed to chase people or wildlife, and may not dig up fencing, bushes or trees. Dogs that dig holes must have their owners fill them in immediately.
- 8. Pinch (prong) and spike collars are not allowed in the leash-free area.
- 9. Infants and toddlers are prohibited from entering the leash-free area. Children between the ages of 6 16 years of age must be accompanied by an adult. Do not allow your children to run and scream, or approach a dog without permission from the dog's owner/guardian.
- 10. Glass containers are not permitted in the park.
- 11. Smoking is not allowed, at any time, on the property.
- 12. For emergencies or situations requiring police, fire or medical assistance, please call 911.
- 13. Dog feces must be cleaned up by the dog owner. Disposal bags are provided.
- 14. Food and drinks are prohibited.
- 15. All dog owners who fail to comply with the rules will be expelled from the park.
- 16 . Make sure all gates are closed at all times.
