## **“Our Canada: A Celebration of 150 years”**

Weyburn Arts Council, Signal Hill Arts Centre and the City of Weyburn are hosting a public art display for along the Boardwalk and Boardwalk Extension areas entitled “Our Canada: A Celebration of 150 years”.

The project will include 16 banners, featuring Canada themed original artwork by local artists, and will be installed for (at least) one year starting in September 2017 to correspond with Culture Days (September 29, 30 and October 1). During that weekend, a series of “Art Walks” will be held to tour the Boardwalk area and take in the Art on display. A booklet featuring information about each banner will be made available to anyone taking in the Art Walk. Original Artwork will also be on display during this time at Signal Hill Arts Centre.

A jury consisting of Weyburn residents will decide on the winners, who will then have their piece printed on a banner.

Deadline for Applications is June 19<sup>th</sup>, 2017

### **CONDITIONS OF ENTRY**

1. Entrants must reside in the South East Region
2. Works of art must be recent (produced in 2015/2016/2017) and have a theme reflecting what Canada means to you.
3. Works will be accepted from any of the following categories: oil, acrylic, watercolour, pen and ink, pencil, printmaking, photography, clay, fibre, leather, wood, metal, dried flowers, mixed media etc. Works must be photographed, as that photograph will be made into the banner to be displayed.
4. Your application must be accompanied by:
  - 2 images of each design and 1 image of yourself. These are to be submitted as a jpeg file(s) on one memory stick.
  - Artist Statement
  - Artist Bio

5. Photography requirements:

**Min of 75 dpi if the object is full size.**

**If your image is smaller take the picture at 300 - 400 dpi.**

**Max 4 MB in size**

**Uploaded in \*.jpeg**

they see. If your images are too dark, out of focus, or poorly lit, the jurors will not be able to adequately assess your work and may reject your application as a result. If you don't have experience making digital images, we recommend hiring a professional photographer to document your work.

5. The dimensions of the photographed work of the artwork need to be cropped to a 1 wide by 2 high ratio. It must show vertically. Images that do not fit this ratio will not be considered.

6. **Artists wishing to submit work must complete the enclosed entry form and return it by June 19<sup>th</sup>, 2017 to:**

7. **For your work to be juried, you must bring artwork to Signal Hill Arts Centre by June 26<sup>th</sup>, 2017. Artwork must be picked up after being juried by July 10<sup>th</sup>, 2017**

8. If selected, original artwork will be on display at Signal Hill Arts Centre for the months of September and October 2017.

9. Entry fee of \$20 per Artist.
