Responsibilities:

- Perform regular testing of the water to ensure that the quality and safety of the water is maintained;
- Measure and calculate chemical feed rates;
- Fill and maintain chemical feed system;
- Perform tests and record test results required for day to day operations of the Water Treatment Plant;
- Clean and maintain equipment and the Water Treatment Plant facility;
- Maintain accurate records to ensure that regulation standards are being followed;
- Maintenance of plants, reservoirs, booster station and intake for adherence to departmental procedures and safety regulations; and
- Performing other duties as assigned.

Qualifications:

- Possess post-secondary diploma in water and wastewater or environmental science.
- Possess a minimum Class 3 Water Treatment Certification, actively working towards gaining Class 4 certification. *Class 2 applicants may be given consideration if working towards Class 3 certification.*
- Hold a valid Class 5 Driver's license.
