



The Weyburn Arts Council accepts exhibition proposals on an ongoing basis. These are reviewed quarterly by our Curator and our Exhibition Proposal committee. Exhibitions are generally programmed two to three years in advance, with the majority of exhibitions and projects resulting from direct invitations. We welcome the opportunity to review new projects, but we are limited in our ability to accommodate all submissions for exhibitions, especially from artists outside Saskatchewan.

**Submissions must include:**

- An introductory cover letter introducing yourself
- A short, one-page artist’s statement about your work
- A curriculum vitae (CV) \*if applicable\*
- Your current contact information and email address
- A list of works with title, date, media and dimensions/duration
- Clearly labeled support materials and images

In the event that the proposed artworks have not yet been produced, please provide a detailed description of the intent in addition to support material featuring your past work.

**Submissions by Mail**

Your submission will be returned if you clearly express your wish for it to be, and if it is accompanied by a self-addressed envelope with the required postage. If you would like your submission kept for later consideration, please note that as well.

CDs, DVDs, and printed images may be submitted using the following guidelines:

- Individual images must be PC-compatible JPEGs
- All PDF documents must be PC-compatible and must not exceed 10MB.
- Videos must be PC compatible and viewable using Windows Media Player.

### Please keep the following in mind:

- We read all submissions sent to us. We will not respond back to submissions unless we are interested in exhibiting your work. There is no need to send multiple follow-up emails on your submission.
- We are a very small staff of one, dedicated employee with a handful of volunteers. Please make sure to familiarize yourself with our three venues before sending us your submission.
- Our venues are:
  - **Allie Griffin Art Gallery:** our largest gallery is located at the Weyburn Public Library. It features provincial and national artists, well known artists from SE Saskatchewan and our long running Peoples' Choice Exhibition. Curatorial assistance offered. (currently booked through 2021)
  - **The Second Floor Gallery** at Signal Hill Arts Centre: features artists from Weyburn and the rest of SE Saskatchewan. Curatorial assistance is provided. (currently booked through 2021)
  - **The Credit Union Gallery:** perfect for first time exhibitors. Our Curator will work with you to help make your show (if booked) cohesive in message, medium and more.

### All of our galleries program in two month installations.

In 2022, we will be moving to new gallery space in the Weyburn Rec and Culture Centre. This move will see the closing of the Allie Griffin Art Gallery and the Second Floor Gallery. Our new gallery will be larger than these two galleries combined, and will feature many modern amenities.
