APPLICATION PROCESS

1. Print and complete the application form
2. Send your completed application to:
 - a. Scan and email to weyburnartscouncil@weyburn.ca,
 - b. Send a picture of your completed form to us via a PM at Weyburn Arts Council on Facebook
3. Six (6) to ten (10) digital images. Please include an image list detailing the title, medium, size and price of the items pictured. Your images should reflect a cohesive body of work. They should resemble (in terms of medium and style) the artworks you intend to showcase at the fair. Please format your images in either JPEG or PNG file formats. These photos will be used by our jury and to promote your presence as our art market.

Thank you for your interest in becoming an exhibitor at the Weyburn Art Council's (WAC) Gifted Holiday Art Market. We welcome individual artists and makers working in an array of mediums, at any stage of their careers with formal or informal training, to apply to be a part of our annual holiday event.

Registration forms are due: September 30th, 2020

Your registration will be reviewed by a panel of 3 WAC directors. The use of juries is a common practice in the visual arts. By utilizing this system, the work is viewed objectively by 3 different persons, not being subjected to the personal tastes of one person. We are using the jury system to ensure that the work for sale at our market is of the highest possible quality with little repetition. The panel will evaluate all 6 of your provided digital images.

Jurying will occur October 8th. You will receive confirmation October 9th.

As we are expecting gathering size limitations and social distancing to still be in effect, we will be accepting a smaller number of artists than we have in years past.

This event is being held November 21st, 2020.

A table and one chair will be provided. Each artist will receive a 10x10 area to set up their work in. There is no wall hanging available.

One artist per booth. Booth sharing is prohibited and will result in expulsion. No 3rd party selling; you must be the creator of what you are selling.

The sale will run 10-5. Artist set up will begin at 8am. We ask that all artists be set up and in place by 9:30am. If you are not at the event and setting up by 9am, you will lose your space without a refund. Booths are to remain up until 5pm.

WAC/SHAC are in no way responsible for your valuables. All artists must follow the guidelines set forth by Weyburn Arts Council.

Booth space is \$25. Weyburn Arts Council is a non-profit organization. Our event fees are low in order to keep this event financially accessible to all who would like to enter.

As 2020 is quite unpredictable, WAC has decided to postpone artist payments for booth space until the day of the sale. When you come to set up your booth, please have the \$25 ready to give to a WAC member.

We may have to cancel the sale with relatively short notice, to adhere to provincial Covid regulations. We will be in contact with artists regularly as the sale date approaches.

Thank you for your understanding. We believe providing artists with avenues of sale is vital to the continued health of our arts community and will endeavor to bring this event to fruition in a way that is safe and accessible to all.
