



MAIL-IN BALLOT ELECTRONIC APPLICATION



Starting Sept. 1, 2020, applications for mail-in ballot packages will only be accepted for the **2020 Municipal Election**. The deadline to apply electronically for a mail-in ballot package is 4:30 p.m. on Oct. 30, 2020.

If applying electronically:

- Applicants can request an electronic application package from the Returning Officer by email at election@weyburn.ca.
- **The deadline to apply electronically for a mail-in ballot package is 4:30 p.m. on Oct. 30, 2020.**
- Be sure to scan or copy original copies of all required identification.
- The mail-in ballot package will include a Voter's Registration and Declaration Form for voters to complete.
- Required identification would include a valid drivers' license or other government issued picture identification; or as per [Section 14 of the Local Government Elections Act Regulations](#).
- A witness can be any of the following:
 - i. The Returning Officer
 - ii. The Deputy Returning Officer
 - iii. The Enumerator
 - iv. Any other person authorized to sign oaths; or
 - v. Family member as defined in attached [Appendix D, Table 2](#) from *The Local Government Election, Regulations, 2015*
 - vi. Someone living at the same address or a neighbor, providing the witness is an eligible voter as defined on the [LEGA Regulations](#), and the witness has known the voter for at least two (2) year or more
 - vii. Any Saskatchewan Health Authority employee currently employed in a hospital, rehabilitation centre, senior assisted-living facility, long-term care facility, or care home governed by or affiliated with the Saskatchewan Health Authority
- Applications must include a scanned or photocopied piece(s) of identification for the voter and the witness if not an 'occupation based professional' (*as set out above in sections i, ii, iii and iv*) or a Saskatchewan Health Authority employee (*as set out above in section vii*).
