### MAIL-IN BALLOT

Apply for mail-in ballots at the Returning Office in city hall with photo ID prior to Nov. 6

Register electronically by emailing the Returning Officer at [election@weyburn.ca](mailto:election@weyburn.ca) by Oct. 30

## HOW TO VOTE

When you arrive at the polling station, you will be asked to provide your voter's registration form, which can be found on the city's website (address), and provide acceptable voter ID. If you do not arrive with a completed registration form, an election official will assist you.

Qualified voters will receive a ballot with the following:

- Mayor for the City of Weyburn. Select **one** name only.
- Councillors for the City of Weyburn. Select up to **six**.
- South East Cornerstone Public School Division trustees in the City of Weyburn. Select up to **two**.

*\*\*The two seats open on the board of trustees for the Holy Family Roman Catholic Separate School Division No. 140 were declared by acclamation; candidates Bruno Tuchscherer and Jerome Sidloski were elected.*

**Reminder:** Clearly mark your choice by filling in the entire circle.



# VOTER ID

## ACCEPTABLE PHOTO IDENTIFICATION

- A valid Saskatchewan Driver's License.
- A valid Saskatchewan ID card issued by SGI or any motor license issuer.
- Any other valid government issued photo ID issued by a Canadian government whether federal, provincial or municipal, or an agency of that government, so long as it includes your name and address.

## ACCEPTABLE NON-PHOTO IDENTIFICATION OPTIONS

If you don't have photo identification and are unable to obtain it before election day, you can present **two** other pieces of information, as long as both contain your name and at least one contains your address.

A full list of all acceptable identification can be found on the City of Weyburn website.

# WHO CAN VOTE

All qualified voters may vote to elect one mayor, up to six councillors and up to two public school board of trustees.

## ELIGIBILITY

A person is eligible to vote in a municipal or school division election who, on election day:

- is a Canadian citizen;
- is at least 18 years of age;
- has resided in Saskatchewan for at least six consecutive months immediately preceding day of the election and:
  - has resided in the City of Weyburn, or on land now in the municipality, for at least three consecutive months immediately preceding the day of the election,
- OR
- is the owner of assessable land in the City of Weyburn, or land now situated in the municipality, for at least three consecutive months immediately preceding the day of the election;
- has not already voted in this election.

# RULES OF RESIDENCE

For the purposes of the Local Government Election Act, 2015:

- the residence of a person is the place in which his habitation is fixed and to which, when he is absent from that place, he has the intention of returning;
- a person who is temporarily absent from the place where his habitation is fixed does not lose his residence;
- no person, while he remains in the province, is deemed to have lost his residence until he has acquired another residence;
- no person has more than one residence in the province and, if he has more than one home in the province, he shall elect one home as his residence.

## VOTING SAFELY

The municipal election on Nov. 9, 2020 will be different than past electoral events in the City of Weyburn.

New processes and safety measures will be in place to protect voters, election workers and candidate representatives at the polls and Returning Office.

Voting safely is our priority for this election. Some things you may notice include:

- Physical distancing in the polls.
- We strongly recommend wearing a mask at the polls.
- Hand sanitizer and masks will be available at all polls.
- Surfaces will be disinfected throughout the day.
- Voters who feel unwell on election day should stay home. Avoid not being able to vote by exploring other voting options such as advance voting or mail-in ballot.
