In 2020, the Water and Sewer Utility operating revenues covered 123% of the Utility expenditures. The Fund surplus was transferred to reserves and were used to in the Water Treatment Plant expansion, reservoir upgrades and watermain capital replacements. Reserves and grants were used to fund capital expenditures.
