Welcome

Weyburn is located on Treaty 4 Territory

The Credit Union Spark Centre and the City of Weyburn are located on traditional lands, referred to as Treaty 4 Territory. Treaty 4 territory is part of the original lands of the Cree, Saulteaux (SO-TO), Dakota, Nakota, Lakota, and the homeland of the Métis Nation. We respect and honour the Treaties that were made on all territories, we acknowledge the harms and mistakes of the past, and we are committed to move forward in partnership with Indigenous Nations in the spirit of reconciliation and collaboration. We are all treaty people.

A Treaty is a formal agreement between two or more states in reference to peace, alliance, commerce, or other international relations. The numbered Treaties are sacred internationally recognized covenants that created a relationship between the British Crown and First Nations. Treaty 4 took six days to complete, being signed on September 15th, 1874.

Acknowledging territory shows recognition of and respect for Indigenous Peoples. It is recognition of their presence in the past, the present and in the future. Recognition and respect are essential elements of establishing healthy, reciprocal relationships. These relationships are key to reconciliation.

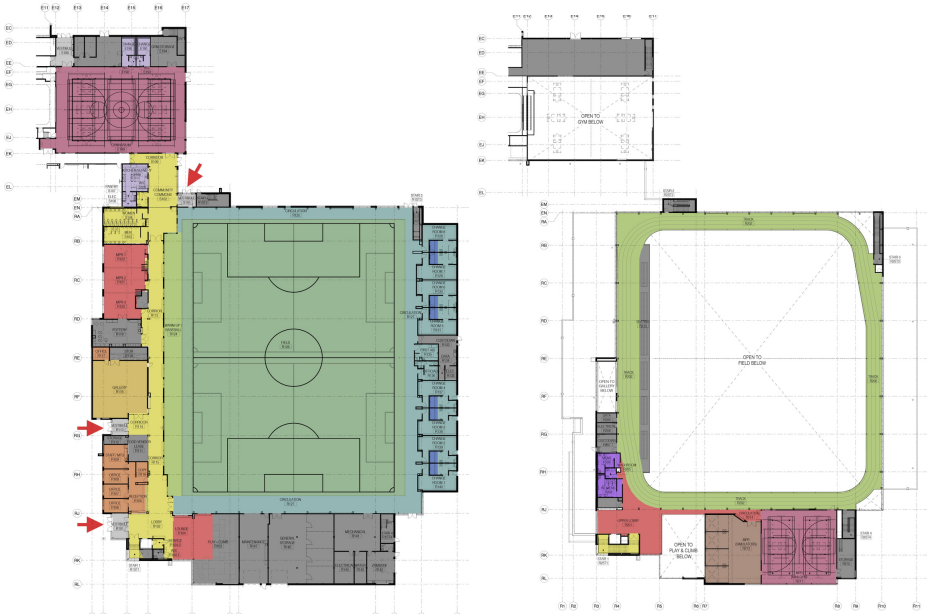

February 1 –March 23:

Scissor Cuts / Scherenschnitte

Scherenschnitte (scissor cuts) is an art form where silhouettes are cut from one piece of special black paper with scissors or knives with no 'hangers' - unattached pieces. Scissor cutting has a long history in German folk art; immigrants brought Scherenschnitte to North America in the 17th Century. Reflecting the Canadian artists in Scissor Cuts/ Scherenschnitte, this collection of works ranges from traditional German Scherenschnitte represented by Waltraude Stehwiem, a German immigrant, to papercut evolved into sculpture by Jess Richter- second generation born in Canada.

Rate Explanations

Credit Union Spark Centre Membership: This allows access to anything labelled as drop in on the program schedule. This may include (MNP Climb Play Centre access, track use, open gym Times, open Mainil Field times etc.) We offer these monthly, in (10) punch cards, 3-month, 6 month and annual memberships. Monthly payment plans can be arranged for all the above excluding 1 month and punch passes. Clients must have accounts with a valid credit card on file to use a payment plan.

Leisure Super Pass: This includes any drop-in program that is offered by the city of Weyburn. This gives you access to drop-in programs at the Credit Union Spark Centre and The Weyburn Leisure Centre. (MNP Play Centre access, track use, open gym times, open Mainil Field times ,public swim, lane Swim etc.) We offer these monthly, in (10) punch cards, 3-month, 6 month and annual memberships. Payment plans can be arranged for all excluding 1 month and punch passes. Clients must have accounts with a valid credit card on file to use a payment plan.

Facility Drop-in Rate: This grants admission to the Credit Union Spark Centre by paying this rate you get access to any drop-in program happening that day on a per person basis. We have different fees for different ages. Children under 5 get free access unless they are using the MNP Play Centre. If you are a valid membership holder you do not need to pay this fee. Drop in access is based on capacity.

Group Drop-in Rate: This is only available to those groups who are 10+ people making one payment.

MNP Play Centre Fee: Children under 5 will pay \$5.00. This is unless they are a valid membership holder.

Parent MNP Play Centre Fee: Parents accessing the MNP Play Structure with their kids must pay a \$3.00 fee unless they are a valid membership holder.

Child Minding: This Service will only be offered during Special Events.

Prime Hours: Prime hours are from 4:00pm-10:00pm Monday-Friday & All day on weekends.

Non-Prime Hours: Weekdays between 6:30am-4:00pm. (Excluding Holidays)

General Use Guidelines

GENERAL USE GUIDELINES

All persons entering the Spark Centre are obliged to govern themselves in accordance with the regulations posted in the Spark Centre.

The management reserves the right to remove any person from the facility and/or suspend any person for a discretionary period of time with just cause.

Rowdiness, horseplay, running, foul language, physical violence and other such acts which disrupt the program or the enjoyment of the event by our patrons or compromises public safety will not be tolerated. Persistence in these acts will result in eviction from the facility.

Anyone found deliberately defacing or damaging the facilities will be responsible for making restitution for those damages. Depending on the extent of damages, suspension from the facilities and criminal prosecution of the individual(s) will be at the discretion of management.

Alcoholic beverages are not allowed on the premises of any recreation facility unless an Authorized Permit for such an event is secured and posted in accordance with Saskatchewan Liquor and Gaming Authority and approval given by Weyburn City Council or the Director of Leisure Services (dependent upon the type of permit required). When serving liquor only plastic glasses and cans are allowable in the facility - no glass. The Weyburn Art Gallery is the only exception with allowance to use glass for special events inside the Gallery.

Management and staff will not be held responsible for loss or theft of articles within and on the recreation facility properties.

Coaches, managers, supervisory or authorized personnel hosting an event will be responsible for the conduct of all participants associated with their program.

The use of equipment within the recreation facilities will be authorized, provided those operators are fully trained in the proper use of the equipment prior to its use.

Children **MUST** be at least 11 years of age to be in the facility by themselves.



Track Rules

Indoor Running and Walking Track Rules

For the comfort and safety of yourself and others, please adhere to the following guidelines:

1. Use the track at your own risk. Track is unsupervised.
2. Indoor shoes only. Outdoor footwear, cleats, open toe shoes, socks and bare feet are not permitted.
3. Proof of payment is required at all times. Teams and individuals must check in at Customer Services prior to track use.
4. Youth under the age of 11 must be accompanied by an adult of at least 18 years of age at all times on the track.
5. The inside lane is for walkers only. Joggers and runners must use the outside lane. Middle lane is to be used as passing lane.
6. All individuals must travel in the same direction.
7. Use caution when entering and exiting the track and change lanes.
8. Food and drink are not allowed on the track.
9. Spectators are not allowed on the track.
10. Absolutely no spitting on the track.
11. For safety reasons, please do not stop on the track. Use designated areas for stretching and exercising.
12. Personal items should be stored in the lockers provided. Lockers are for daily use only.
13. Track may be closed for special events. (Please see posted schedules).
14. Management reserves the right to deny any person access to the track for behavior deemed inappropriate. The City of Weyburn is not responsible for theft, loss or damage to personal property.
15. Strollers, wheelchairs and walking aids are permitted on the track. Please ensure the wheels are clean.
16. In-line skates, skateboards, wheelies and bicycles are not permitted.
17. Report any accident, injury or equipment breakdown immediately to a staff member.
18. Consult a physician before beginning an exercise program. Thank you for your cooperation.

A: The Credit Union Spark Centre is a multi-purpose sports, culture and recreation facility that will offer important healthy and accessible opportunities to our community.

Q: Does my birthday party rental include the climbing wall?

A: No, do have the climbing wall running you are required to pay a fee for a certified programmer which is \$20.00/hr.

Q: Covid info (Mask, vaccine info, etc.)

A: Masks are currently mandated in all public facilities including the Spark Centre. Updates will be provided as they change.

Q. On the Simulators do I need my own golf clubs?

A. Yes, we do not provide clubs but do provide balls as we do not want marks on our screens

Q. Can I bring food upstairs?

A. No, unless you have privately rented a room and have permission from the Leisure Services Manager.

Q. What are Open times?

A. These are open facility times where you can drop and use the space as you wish if the activity isn't impeding the area for the rest of the public.

Q: If I have a rental do, I still pay a drop-in admission fee?

A: No, if you have a private rental our staff will know just identify the group, you're with and you can head to your group's rentals

Q: Can I leave my shoes at the front?

A: No, we have lockers and cubbies for you to put these in.

Q: What footwear should I wear on the track?

A: Indoor clean shoes. Street shoes are not permitted.

Q: What are drop-in times?

A: These are unstructured hours of facility use for the public to utilize either by owning a membership or paying a drop-in fee.

Q: Can I use the facility whenever I want?

A: Yes, but you can only use amenities (Mini gym, Turf, Climbing Wall, track etc. on scheduled times)

Q: What are Waivers?

A: These are to cover the Credit Union Spark Centre of any liability.

A: What is an informed consent waiver?

Q: This is a waiver a parent/guardian must fill out for anyone under 18 to participate in Spark Center Programming.

Q: How long is a signed waiver good for?

A: One year.
