

Smoke and Carbon Monoxide Alarms Requirements for ALL Residential Uses

Effective July 1, 2022 both carbon monoxide (CO) and smoke alarms will be required in all buildings in Saskatchewan which contain a residential occupancy. Residential occupancy is defined as "the occupancy or use of a building or part by persons for who sleeping accommodation is provided" such as a dwelling, duplex, apartment building, townhouse, hotel, secondary suite, basement suite, etc.
