In 2021, the Water and Sewer Utility operating revenues covered 125% of the Utility expenditures. The Fund surplus was transferred to reserves and were used to in the Water Treatment Plant upgrades, lift station upgrades and watermain capital replacements. Reserves and grants are used to fund capital expenditures.
