YOUR GUIDE TO CITY OF WEYBURN **RECREATION FACILITIES**







The City of Weyburn and the RM of Weyburn No.67 are located on traditional lands, referred to as Treaty 4 Territory.

Treaty 4 territory is part of the original lands of the Nêhiyawak (Cree), Nahkawé (Saulteaux) and Nakota and homeland of the Métis, Dakota and Lakota.

When Canada (British Crown) wanted to access the land in what is now western Canada, they negotiated the Numbered Treaties 1 - 11 with First Nations who held their traditional lands on the prairies. The Nêhiyawak, Nahkawê, and Nakota Nations had traditional lands in what is now Treaty 4 Territory. Therefore, when Canada (British Crown) wanted to access the lands in this area, they had to make treaty with Nêhiyawak, Nahkawe and Nakota Nations.

The Dakota, Lakota and Métis did not have traditional lands in this area when Treaty 4 was made, however, a number of Dakota, Lakota and Métis people were settled on these lands prior to and at the time Treaty 4 was made September 15, 1874, therefore, we acknowledge Treaty 4 as their homeland.

We respect and honour the Treaties that were made on all territories. We acknowledge the harms and mistakes of the past, and we are committed to moving forward in partnership with Indigenous Nations in the spirit of reconciliation and collaboration. We are all treaty people.

As the phrase "We are all Treaty people" implies, both Indigenous and non-Indigenous people in Saskatchewan are part of the treaty. Acknowledging territory and treaty shows recognition of and respect for Indigenous Peoples. It is recognition of their presence in our past, our present and in our future. Recognition and respect are essential elements of establishing and maintaining healthy, reciprocal relationships that are the key to reconciliation.

Sepak Takraw, also called kick volleyball, is a team sport played with a ball made of rattan or synthetic plastic between two teams of two to four players on a court resembling a badminton court. It is similar to volleyball and footvolley in its use of a rattan ball and players using only their feet, knees, shoulders, chest and head to touch the ball. Sepak Takraw is often referred to as a mixture of volleyball, due to its use of a net, and association football, as players use their feet.





Weyburn Leisure Centre

The Weyburn Leisure Centre is Weyburn's year round aquatic facility. The Harry Church Junior Olympic Sized Indoor Pool operates from September until May and will open for the season on Monday, September 13. The facility is equipped with a large multipurpose room, a smaller meeting room and a mezzanine. These rooms accommodate fitness classes, meetings and special events.

The change rooms are equipped with showers and lockers. Locks are available for patrons to rent daily (\$5/day, \$4 returned upon exit - cash only), or monthly. Patrons may also bring their own locks for daily use.

Whether parking on the street or in the adjoining parking lot, entrances are wheelchair accessible.

 - Starfish/Duck (4 month 24 months, parented)
 - Age based program for babies and their caregivers.
 - Sea Turtle (24 36 months, parented)
 - Age based program for toddlers and their caregivers
 - Sea Otter (3 5 years)
 - All children start here once they are 3 years old, if they've never taken lessons before
 - Salamander (3 5 years)
 - Pre-requisite: Must have completed Sea Otter

Sunfish (3 – 5 years)

Pre-requisite: Must have completed Salamander

Crocodile/Whale (3 - 5 years)



Bronze Medal Awards

Learn lifesaving skills that will last a lifetime. Whether for personal interest or to become a lifeguard, the Bronze Medal awards provide important water safety messages and develop proficiency in lifesaving, resuscitation and water rescue.

The Bronze Medal award family gets you on the fast track towards developing the fitness, skills and knowledge to perform a water rescue and respond to a non-aquatic emergency.

Bronze Medallion and Bronze Cross are prerequisites for the National Lifeguard award.

Bronze Star

Bronze Star develops swimming proficiency, lifesaving skill and personal fitness. Candidates refine their stroke mechanics, acquire self-rescue skills, and apply fitness principles in training workouts. Bronze Star is excellent preparation for success in Bronze Medallion and provides a fun introduction to lifesaving sport. Includes a 400 metre fitness challenge workout (no time).

Prerequisites: No age requirement; swimming ability required; recommend Swimmer 6 and/or Swim

Patrol

Course date: TBD

Bronze Medallion

Bronze Medallion challenges the candidate both mentally and physically. Judgment, knowledge, skill, and fitness - the four components of water rescue - form the basis of Bronze Medallion training. Candidates acquire the assessment and problem-solving skills needed to make good decisions in, on and around the water. Stroke mechanics, endurance, and rescue of others are included. Bronze Medallion is a prerequisite for assistant lifeguard training in Bronze Cross. Includes a 400 metre timed swim within 12 minutes.

Prerequisites: 13 years of age OR Bronze Star certification (need not be current)

Bronze Cross

Bronze Cross begins the transition from lifesaving to lifeguarding and prepares candidates for responsibilities as assistant lifeguards. Candidates strengthen and expand their lifesaving skills and begin to apply the principles and techniques of active surveillance in aquatic facilities. Bronze Cross emphasizes the importance of teamwork and communication in preventing and responding to aquatic emergencies. Stroke mechanics and endurance are also included. Bronze Cross is a prerequisite for advanced training in the Society's National Lifeguard award (NLS) and leadership certification programs such as Lifesaving Instructor. Includes a 400 metre timed swim within 11 minutes.



National Lifeguard Award

The National Lifeguard award builds on the fundamental skills, knowledge and values taught in the lifesaving awards of the Lifesaving Society to develop the practical skills and knowledge required by lifeguards.

Recognized as the standard measurement of the lifeguard performance in Canada, National Lifeguard Award education is designed to develop a sound understanding of lifeguarding principles, good judgement and a mature and responsible attitude toward the role of the lifeguard. The National Lifeguard's primary role is the prevention of emergency situations and where this fails, the timely and effective resolution of emergencies. The National Lifeguard program is designed to prepare lifeguards to fulfill this role as professional facilitators of safe, enjoyable aquatics.

National Lifeguard - Pool

National Lifeguard certification is Canada's professional lifeguard standard. National Lifeguard training develops a sound understanding of lifeguarding principles, good judgment, and a mature and responsible attitude towards the lifeguard's role. National Lifeguard training emphasizes prevention and effective rescue response in emergencies including first aid treatment. Candidates develop teamwork, leadership and communication skills. Fitness requirements include a timed object recovery, 50 m sprint challenge, 50 m rescue drill and 400 m endurance challenge. Pre-Requisite: Minimum 15 years of age, Bronze Cross Award (need not be current), Standard First Aid/CPR-C Award or Aquatic Emergency Care/CPR-C Award

National Lifeguard Recertification

National Lifeguard certification is valid for 24 months (2 years) from the date of the exam. In order to remain current, National Lifeguards must attend an in-person recert exam before they expire. This exam ensures that all National Lifeguards are remaining at the National Lifeguard standard.

Note: As long as you have held a National Lifeguard certification you can attend a recert. However in-between the time of expiration and the recert exam you are not considered certified by the Lifesaving Society.

Crescent Point Place

The Weyburn Colosseum was built in 1960 and has had several renovations and expansion projects done to enhance the facility.

With the renovation process, naming rights of the facility were purchased by Crescent Point Energy Trust in 2008, and the arena is now known as Crescent Point Place.

Crescent Point Place is an excellent facility for all types of activities. This facility has a regulation size ice surface $(85' \times 200')$, a seating capacity of 1475 (view the seating chart here), standing area, private boxes and viewing from the lobby (1900 total capacity).

Tom Zandee Sports Arena

The Tom Zandee Sports Arena was built in 1982 adjacent to Crescent Point Place as a second ice facility, with an ice surface of 85 feet by 190 feet and a seating capacity of 400 through out the lobby, main level and upper level




