The City of Weyburn and the RM of Weyburn No. 67 are located on traditional lands, referred to as Treaty 4 territory.

Treaty 4 territory is part of the original lands of the Nêhiyawak (Cree), Nahkawé (Saulteaux) and Nakota and homeland of the Métis, Dakota and Lakota.

When Canada (British Crown) wanted to access the land in what is now western Canada, they negotiated the Numbered Treaties 1 – 11 with First Nations who held their traditional lands on the prairies. The Nêhiyawak, Nahkawê, and Nakota Nations had traditional lands in what is now Treaty 4 territory. Therefore, when Canada (British Crown) wanted to access the lands in this area, they had to make treaty with Nêhiyawak, Nahkawe and Nakota Nations.

The Dakota, Lakota and Métis did not have traditional lands in this area when Treaty 4 was made, however, a number of Dakota, Lakota and Métis people were settled on these lands prior to and at the time Treaty 4 was made September 15, 1874, therefore, we acknowledge Treaty 4 as their homeland.

We respect and honour the Treaties that were made on all territories. We acknowledge the harms and mistakes of the past, and we are committed to moving forward in partnership with Indigenous Nations in the spirit of reconciliation and collaboration. We are all treaty people.

As the phrase "We are all treaty people" implies, both Indigenous and non-Indigenous people in Saskatchewan are part of the treaty. Acknowledging territory and treaty shows recognition of and respect for Indigenous Peoples. It is recognition of their presence in our past, our present and in our future. Recognition and respect are essential elements of establishing and maintaining healthy, reciprocal relationships that are the key to reconciliation.

Spirit of Nature - Looking Beyond Yourself

Phyllis Poitras-Jarrett

The Spirit of Nature - Looking Beyond Yourself features fifteen paintings of different animals and insects. Each creature's silhouette is filled with intricate Métis floral beadwork patterning. Swirling around the forms of the fauna is a diaphanous grey fog, a representation of the spirit world. Phyllis says "Each animal painting is adorned with a unique, colourful, symmetrical Métis floral beadwork design...Each bead, flower and animal are a part of something greater. Within each painting, the grey background and white flowers represent the greater universe. Hidden in each painting is a glass spirit bead. This bead, in traditional Métis beadwork, was an off colour or misplaced bead. The spirit bead symbolizes humility and it reminds us, humans are not perfect. Therefore, we need to learn to be mindful that each day is an opportunity to make improvements in ourselves for the betterment of "All of Our Relations"."

The Weyburn Leisure Centre is Weyburn's year round aquatic facility. The Harry Church Junior Olympic-sized indoor pool operates from September 11 until June 2. The facility is equipped with a large multipurpose room, a smaller meeting room and a mezzanine. These rooms accommodate fitness classes, meetings and special events.

The six lane junior Olympic-sized outdoor pool operates from June 10 to August 25 and is appealing to all ages with its tot pool, beach entry with spray elements, twin speed slide, 3-metre and 1- metre diving board and climbing wall.

The change rooms are equipped with showers and lockers. Locks are available for patrons to rent daily (\$5/day, \$4 returned upon exit – cash only) or monthly. Patrons may also bring their own locks for daily use.

Whether parking on the street or in the adjoining parking lot, entrances are wheelchair accessible.

Registered Programs - Swim for Life

SWIM FOR LIFE ® PROGRAM OVERVIEW

Learning to swim opens up a world of recreation opportunities. The Lifesaving Society's Swim for Life ® program teaches swimmers water safety and swimming skills. Learn with your young child in parent and tot classes. Preschoolers and children learn confidence and independence in group classes. Youth build strength and endurance to learn lifesaving skills. Swimming is an important, lifelong skill where there is something for everyone!

Parent & Tot (4 - 36 months)

The Parent & Tot program structure in-water interaction between parent and child to stress the importance of play in developing water-positive attitudes and skill. Activities and progressions are based on child development, so parents register in the level appropriate for their child's age. For ages 4 months up to 3 years.

- Parent & Tot 1 (4 month 12 months, parented)
- Parent & Tot 2 (12 24 months, parented)
- Parent & Tot 3 (2 3 years, parented)

Preschool (3 - 5 years)

The Preschool program is targeted to 3 – 5 years old. An instructor leads the lesson in water (no parent/caregiver). Preschool levels cover basic swimming skills and orientation such as getting face wet, front and back floats, glides, use of PFD's, basic front and back swims, and entries and exits. Water Smart ® education is also incorporated in to the levels.

- Pre-school 1 (3 5 years)
 - No lesson experience and/or just starting on their own
- Pre-school 2 (3 5 years)
 - Can jump in to chest deep water assisted, floats, glides on their front and back, blows bubbles and can get face wet, assisted
- Pre-school 3 (3 5 years)
 - Can jump into chest-deep water unassisted; submerge and exhale under water for 3 seconds; front and back floats wearing a PFD for 3 seconds
- Pre-school 4 (3 5 years)
 - Can jump in to water wearing a PFD; hold breath under water for 3 seconds; front and back floats for 5 seconds; glide and kick on front and back for 5 metres (all skills must be preformed unassisted)
- Pre-school 5 (3 5 years)
 - Can jump into deep water; side glide 3 metres; front float, roll to back float and then swim 5 metres;
 flutter kick on front and on back 7 metres; front crawl wearing a PFD for 5 metres.

Swimmer (6 – 12 years old)

The Swimmer program targets 6–12 year olds. Swimmer levels centre around self-rescue, basic swimming skills, swimming strokes and fitness. Front and back floats, glides, dives, forward roles, front crawl, back crawl, breaststroke, plus a variety of kicks such as flutter kick, whip kick, scissor kick and eggbeater kick. Water Smart ® education is part of every level.

Registered Programs - Lifesaving & Lifeguarding



BRONZE MEDALLION

Bronze Medallion challenges the candidate both mentally and physically. Judgment, knowledge, skill, and fitness – the four components of water rescue – form the basis of Bronze Medallion training. Candidates acquire the assessment and problem-solving skills needed to make good decisions in, on and around the water. Stroke mechanics, endurance, and rescue of others are included. Bronze Medallion is a prerequisite for assistant lifeguard training in Bronze Cross. Includes a 400-metre timed swim within 12 minutes.

BRONZE CROSS

Bronze Cross begins the transition from lifesaving to lifeguarding and prepares candidates for responsibilities as assistant lifeguards. Bronze Cross is a prerequisite for advanced training in the Society's National Lifeguard award (NLS) and leadership certification programs such as Lifesaving Instructor. Includes a 400-metre timed swim within 11 minutes.

NATIONAL LIFEGUARD - POOL

National Lifeguard certification is Canada's professional lifeguard standard. Candidates develop teamwork, leadership and communication skills. Fitness requirements include a timed object recovery, 50 m sprint challenge, 50 m rescue drill and 400 m endurance challenge.

SWIM FOR LIFE & LIFESAVING INSTRUCTOR

This combined course of the Lifesaving Society's Swim for Life Instructor and Lifesaving Instructor is a leadership course that provides candidates with theory, knowledge and skill and practice to teach and certify in the Swim for Life Program.

CRESCENT POINT PLACE

The Weyburn Colosseum was built in 1960 and has had several renovations and expansion projects done to enhance the facility.

With the renovation process, naming rights of the facility were purchased by Crescent Point Energy Trust in 2008, and the arena is now known as Crescent Point Place.

Crescent Point Place is an excellent facility for all types of activities. This facility has a regulation size ice surface (85ft x 200ft), a seating capacity of 1475, standing area, private boxes and viewing from the lobby (1900 total capacity).

TOM ZANDEE SPORTS ARENA

The Tom Zandee Sports Arena was built in 1982 adjacent to Crescent Point Place as a second ice facility, with an ice surface of 85ft x 190ft and a seating capacity of 400 through out the lobby, main level and upper level.



CROSS COUNTRY SKI TRAILS & RENTALS


