For 2022, waterworks revenues covered 118% of the waterworks expenditures and debt payments.

The surplus was transferred to reserves and used in the Water Treatment Plant upgrades, lift station upgrades and watermain capital replacements. Reserves and grants are used to fund capital expenditures.
