- Maintain accurate documentation, records, and reports as required.
- Submit weekly reports, attend team meetings, and participate in planned events during the workday.
- Supervise and create opportunities for both planned and spontaneous play.

- Ensure that all activities are designed and facilitated to meet the needs and abilities of participants.
- Perform additional duties as assigned.
